## RESOLUTION NO. 2024 – 06- D A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF RECLAMATION DISTRICT No. 1600

**RESOLVED** that the work included in Reclamation District No. 1600's ("District") 2024-2025 routine maintenance of District levees and ditches, and/or repair of existing levee improvements, involves negligible or no expansion of said improvements' existing uses and, hence, falls within the categorical exemption to the California Environmental Quality Act set forth in California Code of Regulations, title 14, section 15301; that said work does not constitute an exception to the exemptions of the California Environmental Quality Act; and that the District's Engineer is authorized to prepare and file with the County of Yolo the appropriate Notice of Exemption on behalf of the District.

**FURTHER RESOLVED** that the President of Reclamation District No. 1600 is hereby authorized to execute the resolution on behalf of the District that the routine maintenance work is determined to be categorically exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (Pub. Resources Code, § 21000 et seq.) for the reasons set forth above.
