PG&E bills in the summer. Farmers monitor water level in drain diteches so as not to flood farms. Bypass and Yeung farms can discuss at upcoming meeting an abatement program.

3. Discuss mowing bypass levee and levee from Fremont Weir to CR 16 due to lack of burn days.

Because no burn days, used spray to get broadleaves. Burn day today and get EFPD also a burn. Kyle Lang will coordinate.
